7	Attend a Post 16 open evening	Students must attend at least one Post 16 open evening ensuring they are researching further education courses in areas of interest to them.
8	Take part in/contribute to a charity event	Students must get involved in fundraising events to support local or national charities. These events could be with their tutor group, whole school or open to the local community. For example, Children in Need, or Comic Relief.
9	Attend a Careers Guidance conversation	Students must attend a Careers Guidance conversation in school. Further guidance is always available if required.
10	Complete a college application	Following guidance conversations and attendance to a Post 16 open evening, students must complete at least one college application.
